

Információk a projektről

The main objective of this project is for students of each country to select various digital files (texts, videos, images...) representing their generation and culture and to send them to their partner. Once received, the partner would then comment and exchange on those. These comments would in turn be analysed by the original sources in order to discover and analyse any cultural differences and representations which would then be discussed with the partner. The last step of the project will be to send to chosen recipients the selected files by email to be received in 5 years' time.

CÉLOK

Firstly, pupils will have the opportunity to reflect back on their generation and culture and also determine which tools they need to properly communicate those and how to accurately use these tools.

Secondly, they will discover a new culture as well as identify what representations other cultures have of their own.

Regarding the English language, Pupils will need to use written and oral communication channels as well as being able to extract main ideas from a source and also summarise their own opinions.

Responsibilities for this project are jointly shared. The project will start at the end of February and will probably finish at the end of April. The partners will work separately as well as together. Overall, they should meet three times. The first time will be to introduce ourselves and describe the project in more details, the second will be to exchange on the files received from the other partner and the last to discuss and analyse cultural differences and representations.

Each class will be split in teams. Each team will be paired with a partner's team.
